# **Equine Health Schedules**

### Recommended Healthcare for Horses

At Moore Veterinary Clinic, we care about your horses and want to help keep them healthy and protected from dangerous and contagious diseases. Core vaccinations protect against diseases that are endemic to a region, are virulent/highly contagious, pose a risk of severe disease, those having potential public health significance, and/or are required by law. Core vaccines have clearly demonstrable efficacy and safety, with a high enough level of patient benefit and low enough level of risk to justify their use in all horses. We also offer specific vaccines that your horse may benefit from depending on the environment and lifestyle they live. ALL vaccination programs should be developed in consultation with a licensed veterinarian.

## **ADULT HORSES:**

#### **Schedule** Vaccine Notes Rabies Annual Ideally given in **VEWT** Annual spring, prior to onset of vector season. Ideally given in West Nile Semi-Annual spring, prior to onset Virus of vector season. Flu/Rhino Semi-Annual Strangles Annual

## **FOALS:**

Vaccine	Schedule
Rabies	First vaccine at 4 month
	Second vaccine at 5 months
VEWT	First vaccine at 4 month
	Second vaccine at 5 months
West Nile Virus	First vaccine at 4 month
	Second vaccine at 5 months
Flu/Rhino	First vaccine at 4 month
	Second vaccine at 5 months
Strangles	First vaccine at 9 months
	Second vaccine at 10 months

- Oral Exam/Dental Float recommended annually
- EIA (Coggins) test should be performed once/year
- Fecal test is recommended annually for parasites
- Consult with a veterinarian for a parasite control program tailored to your horse
